This safari includes a scenic one way flight to Bwindi and two nights to allow the opportunity of trekking gorillas twice (permits must be pre-booked), or enjoy a community walk or some forest birding. Chimpanzee trekking in Kibale Forest and Kyamburu (additional permit fee), a boat cruise on the Kazinga Channel, Bigodi swamp walk, plenty of game viewing in Queen Elizabeth National Park.

### 10 MAR: ENTEBBE

Arrive Entebbe meet and greet and transfer to hotel. Overnight hotel in Entebbe. *Karibu Guesthouse (B)* 

### 11 MAR: BWINDI IMPENETRABLE FOREST

Transfer to the airport for your flight to Bwindi (Kihihi). On arrival transfer to Buhoma Lodge for two nights including all meals. enjoy an optional forest walk or cultural visit. *Buhoma Lodge (BLD)* 

### 12 MAR: GORILLA TREKKING

Today enjoy a gorilla trek experience in Bwindi Impenetrable Forest National Park. Depart early for a briefing by experienced guides, then accompanied by guides and trackers, you will embark on a trek through the dense, misty forest in search of one of Bwindi's habituated gorilla families. The trek's duration can vary based on the gorillas' movements, but encountering these incredible creatures in their natural habitat is an unforgettable experience, often described as a once-ina-lifetime opportunity. After spending an awe-inspiring hour observing and photographing the gorillas in their natural environment, return to the lodge for a welldeserved rest. Buhoma Lodge (BLD)

\* HIGHLIGHT: Viewing Gorillas in their own habitat.

### 13/14 MAR: QUEEN ELIZABETH NAT. PARK

Today offers a variety of enriching activities starting with an optional community walk or forest walk near Buhoma. Engage with local communities to learn about their daily lives and cultural practices, gaining insights into their traditions and livelihoods. Alternatively, explore the lush forest on a guided walk, discovering the rich biodiversity of Bwindi Impenetrable National Park with its diverse flora and fauna. In the afternoon, embark

on a picturesque drive to Queen Elizabeth National Park, to Ishasha Wilderness Camp. Ishasha is renowned for its tree-climbing lions and game viewing opportunities. Enjoy game drives and sundowners in Queen Elizabeth N.P. Ishasha Wilderness Camp - 2 nights (BLD) \* HIGHLIGHT: Game drives with the chance to see tree-climbing lions.

### 15 MAR: KAZINGA CHANNEL CRUISE

Drive to the 'northern area' of the National Park for a boat cruise on the Kazinga channel then check in to your camp. *Elephant Plains Camp (BLD)* 

### 16 MAR: CHIMP TREK OR GAME DRIVE

Today offers two exciting options to explore the diverse National Park. You can start your day with a thrilling chimpanzee trekking experience in the Kyambura Gorge or enjoy a game drive in the park. *Elephant Plains Camp (BLD)*

### 2 JUN: HAZYVIEW

This morning we leave for Mpumalanga, dropping several hundred feet into the lush subtropical region of the Lowveld. Travel along the circular Panorama Route, visiting the view sites of the Blyde River Canyon, home to the Three Rondavels and one of the natural wonders of Africa; gasp at the glory of God's Window, with a boundless view of mountains and fertile plains and visit Bourke's Luck Potholes. Hippo Hollow Country Estate (B)

\* HIGHLIGHT: View the spectacular Panorama Route.

### 3 JUN: KRUGER NATIONAL PARK

We have a bright and early start to the day to experience the wonders of exploring the Kruger National Park in our closed vehicle. Why not join a thrilling openvehicle game safari through the Kruger National Park (optional - own account). The Kruger National Park is a world renowned game reserve that supports the largest variety of wildlife species on the African continent. Keep a lookout for the wonderful flora and bird life that abounds. We return to our hotel around lunch time and your afternoon is at leisure to relax. Hippo Hollow Country Estate (B)

### 4 JUN: eSWATINI

This morning we travel to eSwatini (Swaziland), an independent Kingdom within the borders of South Africa, known for its lovely scenery, crafts and colourful indigenous culture. An interactive cultural experience introduces us to the charming people of eSwatini and their traditions. We travel south to our hotel, nestled in the mountainous peaks of eSwatini for overnight. *Piggs Peak Hotel* (B)

### **5 JUN: ST LUCIA AND SURROUNDS**

After breakfast we journey through eSwatini, visiting Ngwenya Glass, where a small group of eSwati craftsmen and women create beautiful handmade items from recycled glass. Our next stop is The Swazi Candles Centre where you will experience local artisans creating colourful, handmade candles. Our journey continues into the Kingdom of KwaZulu-Natal where ancient traditions and modern cultures of both Zulu and Settler have combined into a vibrant society living in peace and harmony. Arrive at your hotel in the late afternoon. Anew Hotel Hluhluwe (B)

### 6 JUN: ST LUCIA TO DURBAN

Guests have the option to take a morning optional open vehicle game drive in the Hluhluwe-iMfolozi Game Reserve (optional and for own account), before heading off to Durban. An orientation tour of Durban, that travels along the Golden Mile, the beachfront promenade, The Point Waterfront, and harbour introduces us to this multicultural, vibrant seaside city.







The Orientation tour concludes with a visit to the Durban Botanic Gardens before arriving at our hotel late afternoon. Protea Hotel Umhlanga Ridge (B)

### 7 JUN: DRAKENSBERG

Enjoy a leisurely breakfast or perhaps explore the bustling Umhlanga Beach with a stroll along the Promenade mile that buzzes with energy as surfers, joggers and cyclists take to this seaside playground. Then we head into the majestic Southern Drakensberg Mountains. We visit the impressive 300-foot-high Howick Falls, located in the KwaZulu-Natal Midlands town of Howick.

Our journey continues through the Southern Midlands Meander Route, arriving at our hotel, situated on a scenic World Heritage site, mid-afternoon. Your afternoon is at leisure to soak up the surroundings, or enjoy fishing, hiking and even horse riding in clean mountain air (all activities are optional and for own account). Sit down to a sumptuous dinner at your hotel. Drakensberg Gardens Hotel (BD)

### **8 JUN: DRAKENSBERG**

Enjoy a full day at leisure to soak up the surroundings of the magnificent Southern Drakensberg Mountains. There are also many leisure activities to be enjoyed at the Resort. Consider joining a thrilling 4x4 tour up the spectacular Sani Pass into the mountain Kingdom of Lesotho (optional and for own account). Enjoy an evening dinner at your hotel with a wide variety of local specialities to choose from. Drakensberg Gardens Hotel (BD)

### 9 JUN: EASTERN CAPE COAST

This morning we continue south to the Eastern Cape entering the fourth of the provinces and the birthplace of Nelson Mandela (fondly known as Madiba). En route we see the old traditional way of life in the former homeland area known as the Transkei and stop for lunch (own account) outside the capital of Mthata. We travel past Nelson Mandela's birthplace and house, arriving late afternoon at our lodge in Chinsta East, on the beautiful, unspoilt Eastern Cape Coast. A delicious dinner with local delicacies awaits you at your lodge. Crawford's Beach Lodge (BD) \* HIGHLIGHT: Drive past Nelson Mandela's birth place and home.

### 10 JUN: EASTERN CAPE COAST

We awake to the sounds of the crashing waves and have the morning at leisure to unwind with beach sand between our toes. The beach stretches on uninterrupted for many kilometres and the thick indigenous beach forest is a haven for an amazing variety of birdlife. We set off heading south to the Tsitsikamma Forest. Tsitsikamma Village Inn (B)

### 11 JUN: KNYSNA

After a leisurely breakfast, visit the spectacularly beautiful Tsitsikamma Forest, which provides scenic walking opportunities. A short walk to the Storms River Mouth offers some magnificent views of the gorge and river below. Arrive in Knysna, known as the oyster box of South Africa, for check in at your hotel. Enjoy a dinner filled with culinary delights at the hotel's trendy restaurant. The Rex Hotel (BD)



After breakfast, we travel inland over the spectacular Outeniqua Pass to Oudtshoorn, known as the 'feather capital of the world' because of its ostrich industry. We visit a working ostrich farm and then explore the famous Cango Caves, with a walk around its magnificent dripstone formations of stalactites and stalagmites. Overnight in Oudtshoorn. Protea Hotel Riempie Estate (B) \* HIGHLIGHT: Take a Guided tractor tour of an Ostrich

### 13 JUN: CAPE TOWN

Today's journey travels along the famous Route 62 and through the Little Karoo, ending in Cape Town. On the way we stop off to sample top quality port style wines in Calitzdorp, before continuing via Worcester and the Huguenot Tunnel, arriving in Cape Town in the late afternoon. Sunsquare Cape Town Gardens (B)

### 14 JUN: AT LEISURE

Enjoy a full day at leisure. Perhaps join a sightseeing tour of Cape Town and Table Mountain (optional and for own account) or spend the day exploring the magnificent Cape Winelands on a full day winelands tour (optional and for own account) or join a full day tour of the Cape Peninsula, with its dramatic coastline and spectacular scenic beauty (optional and for own account). ### 20 JUN: ARRIVE NAIROBI

### 21 JUN: NAIROBI DISCOVERY

Enjoy visits to the informative and interactive Giraffe Centre, the Karen Blixen farmhouse from "Out of Africa" fame – now a museum as well as the Beads Factory, which employs over 300 women. Lunch will be hosted at the Karen Blixen Coffee Garden. Return to your hotel. *Tamarind Tree Hotel (BL)* 

\*HIGHLIGHT: View some of Nairobi's best attractions with the chance to get "kissed" by a giraffe.

### 22/23/24 JUN: AMBOSELI NAT. PARK

Depart early and travel to Amboseli National Park in our 4 x 4 safari vehicle, arriving in time for lunch. Check in to Ol Tukai Lodge, our home for the next three nights and the place we start our gameviewing extravaganza. Morning and afternoon game drives are included.

Amboseli National Park is renowned for its excellent variety of wildlife such as Masaai giraffe, elephant, lion and cheetah and is one of Kenya's most popular Parks. The landscape of Amboseli is dominated by the majestic snow cap of Mt Kilimanjaro, as well as open plains and acacia woodland. Birding is also excellent, especially near the lakes and swamps.

The Park is famous for its large herds of elephants among other wildlife species. Another attraction of the Park is the chance to meet the local Maasai people and soak up some of their culture.

Ol Tukai Lodge is a great place to watch elephants with the backdrop of Africa's highest mountain, Mt Kilimanjaro.







Writers have described Ol Tukai and the surrounding Amboseli National Park as 'A home for the gods'. A place of rugged beauty, abundant water, lush green grass and forest, set like an oasis in the surrounding savannah shrubland.

Ol Tukai Lodge - 3 nights (BLD)

\*HIGHLIGHT: Game viewing in this famous
National Park with Mt Kilimanjaro as your backdrop.

### 25/26 JUN: LAKE NAKURU

plus a visit to a Masaai village.

Enjoy a morning game drive and breakfast before heading off on a journey to Lake Nakuru National Park. The World Heritage Site of The Kenya Lake System, which includes Lake Nakuru National Park, is your next stop. Located on the floor of the Kenyan Great Rift Valley system, this fracture in the earth's crust stretches around 6,500 km from The Middle East to Southern Africa.

On arrival, check in to your lodge for 2 nights. Enjoy lunch before going on safari to explore the Park, which has one of the Rift Valley soda lakes. It is often home to flamingos along with a wide variety of wildlife and birdlife. Enjoy game drives during your stay, *Lake Nakuru Sopa Lodge - 2 nights (BLD)* 

\* HIGHLIGHT: You may get the chance to view flamingos in the lake on a game drive.

### 27/28/29 JUN: THE MASAI MARA

Depart Lake Nakuru and head south towards Kenya's premier wildlife arena the Masai Mara National Reserve.

Stop enroute to visit 'Beats of Beads', a Kenyan non-profit organization - a Women Empowerment Art-centre. Visit the only museum in Africa dedicated to the art of East African beading – on jugs, leather bags, loin cloths, as well as an impressive collection of head and neck ornaments.

The knowledgeable guides will add to the experience showing us the workspace where skilled Maasai women can teach you the art of beading while interacting with them. The nearby store allows the women to sell their art with dignity and under fair trade conditions.

On arrival at our camp, check in for 3 nights. The Masai Mara is known for its spectacular wildlife and large numbers of lions, elephants, rhino, buffalo, wildebeest, giraffe, zebra and more. The undeniable highlight of the Masai Mara is the annual wildebeest migration traversing the vast plains.

During your stay enjoy the rare chance to visit a local school and also partake in a cooking class to discover the spices and cuisine of the Masaai.

Zebra Plains Mara Camp is a small boutique tented camp nestled in the Masai Mara Game Reserve. The camp is set below the Ol Donyo Loip ridge, facing the open plains of the Masai Mara. The ridge is one of the most important wildlife habitats as it is home to some big cats and also a migration corridor.


During our stay, enjoy game drives throughout the reserve with the chance to view the annual migration (subject to climatic conditions).

### 11/12 JUN: SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK

Jerash showcases the grandeur of Imperial Rome (and is sometimes referred to as the Pompeii of the East). It is considered one of the largest, and most well-preserved sites of Roman architecture in the World outside Italy. As the most pristine Decapolis City (meaning ten cities in Greek) in the modern world, Jerash's prosperity can be admired in the collonaded main street and lovely Oval Piazza. Return to Amman. Ambassador Hotel (B)

### 11 OCT: MADABA, MT NEBO & PETRA

Depart for a visit to Mt. Nebo, considered to be one of the most important holy sites in Jordan, as it is believed to be the place where Moses climbed from the Valley of Moab, and from where God showed him the Promised Land, as well as Moses' last resting place. It features ruins from the 4th to the 6th century with marvellous mosaics adorning the grounds of the church still visible.

Continue to visit the Christian Town of Madaba, which is known as 'The City of Mosaics'. You will be visiting the St. George Greek Orthodox Church, where you will see the masterpiece of Madaba (a Byzantine mosaic map of the Holy Land that goes back to the 6th century, showing Jerusalem and other cities), you will also visit the Archaeological Park, which houses the remains of several Byzantine churches, including the amazing mosaics of the Church of the Virgin. The park complex includes a school for the restoration and conservation of ancient mosaics.

We will then move to Shobak to visit the massive Crusader's fortress, originally called Montreal, which was strategically located on a hill along the pilgrimage and caravan routes from Syria to Arabia. Perched in a wild, remote landscape, it is especially imposing when seen from a distance. Continue south to Petra. Petra Guest House (B)

### 12 OCT: PETRA

EWe will start our journey to explore Petra, aptly described as the "Rose-Red city, half as old as time". The ancient city was founded by the Nabateans 2000 years ago. Its massive architectural structure and its multicoloured stones are an incredible attraction. The visit of the ancient Nabatean capital starts on horseback,

followed by a walk through the Siq, a long narrow fissure between two overhanging cliffs. Towards the end of the Siq, you will be spellbound by Petra's most famous monument; the Treasury. The tour then proceeds to gradually unfold the mysteries of the city. *Petra Guest House (B)* 

\* HIGHLIGHT: Visit to Petra's famous Treasury

### 13 OCT: WADI RUM

After breakfast, proceed to Beida (also known as Little Petra) and then to the enchanting desert of Wadi Rum. Enjoy a Jeep Tour and transfer to Sun City Camp for a typical Bedouin dinner and overnight in a unique Martian Dome Tent.
